

# BECOME A PERMANENT RESIDENT OF CANADA

Foreign nationals in Canada could qualify to become permanent residents faster, through the new **Temporary resident to permanent resident pathway**.

Please follow these steps:



## STEP 1: CHECK THAT YOU ARE ELIGIBLE

Visit [Canada.ca/tr-pr](https://Canada.ca/tr-pr) for a full list of eligibility criteria and for details about the program.

Choose from one of the following streams:

- Workers in Canada: Stream A (health care)
- Workers in Canada: Stream B (essential non-health care)
- French-speaking Workers in Canada: Stream A (health care)
- French-speaking Workers in Canada: Stream B (essential, non-health care)
- French-speaking International Graduates

You'll need to prove that you are currently employed in any occupation in Canada, have previously obtained qualifying work experience in an eligible field, have the required language levels, are currently in Canada and that you satisfy the rest of the eligibility criteria. You can use our eligibility tool to answer a few questions and find out if you're eligible.

## STEP 2: CREATE YOUR ACCOUNT, GATHER AND UPLOAD YOUR DOCUMENTS

Once you are sure that you're eligible to apply, you can create your account, answer a few questions about your application, and receive a document checklist. Based on your document checklist, you'll need to complete all of the forms and gather all of the supporting documents.

You'll be able to upload your documents one by one into your account as you gather them. Paper applications are not accepted as part of this program.

Please read **Guide 5069 – Temporary public policy: Temporary Resident to Permanent Resident Pathway (TR to PR Pathway)** closely before applying, to ensure you've submitted all the required documentation.

## STEP 3: PAY YOUR FEES AND SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION

Once you have all your documents, you'll need to pay your fees online, double check that your application is complete and click submit!

## STEP 4: AFTER YOU SUBMIT

After you submit your application, we'll reach out to you for next steps.

We recommend that you link your application to your IRCC account after receiving your acknowledgement of receipt. This will allow you to quickly provide any documents we might ask you for, and will let you track your application.
